Instructions for NSF-Required Responsible Conduct of Research (RCR) Training

Responsible Conduct of Research training is mandated by an NSF ruling that became effective January 4, 2010. The university must certify on every proposal submission to NSF that a program is in place and available to students and postdoctoral fellows. To meet this requirement, the university has subscribed to the online RCR training program provided by the Collaborative Institutional Training initiative (CITI).

To comply with the new NSF award conditions, principal investigators will be responsible for insuring that students and post doctoral fellows have taken and passed the training. Verification is in the form of the CITI completion report that the student /post doc can print from the CITI site. Sponsored Programs will periodically check the CITI site to verify completion of training.

Follow the instructions below to register and complete the online RCR course.
