Working with tools and concepts from Stanford's Hasso Plattner Institute of Design, this unclass helps students tap into skills and activities that motivate and engage them, an important step toward developing stronger direction and purpose. UA students will learn to embrace ambiguity and a bias toward action as they build collaborative models for personal and professional efficacy. Students will conduct interviews with APS students and Akron-area professionals from a variety of disciplines about their career choices. Using their research, they will co-design workshop prototypes for high school seniors. Giving students a shared set of tools they can use to navigate from high school through college is likely to increase student retention and success after graduation.

Unclasses are small, interdisciplinary, hands-on courses. Students may enroll under the course number listed or work with Dr. Behrman in EX[L] to receive Independent Study, Honors, or other types of course credit. behrman@uakron.edu.
