Frequently Asked Questions

When should I arrive for my campus visit?

Please plan to arrive at the Transfer & Adult Enrollment Center located in Simmons Hall, Room 209, **no more than 10 minutes** before your scheduled time.

What should I expect when I arrive?

When you arrive at the Transfer & Adult Enrollment Center, our staff will check you in at the front desk, where we have installed plexiglass for their safety and yours.

How many guests will I be able to bring?

You may bring one guest to the appointment and tour with you.

Should I bring a face covering?

To ensure the health and safety of our visitors and employees, you and admission staff members **are required** to wear a face covering. If you do not have one, one will be provided for you.

How will you safely conduct an appointment?

Appointments will be conducted by an admissions counselor adhering to social distancing guidelines in a sanitized office space. After each appointment, we will re-sanitize the room.

How will you facilitate social distancing during a tour?

On tour, you and your guide will wear a face covering and will maintain six feet of separation.

Will I be able to enter the residence halls on my tour?

At this time, to adhere to strict safety standards, we are not able to showcase the interiors of residence halls on our tours. You can access our virtual residence hall tours at uakron.edu/reslife/halls/360-video.

Will there be dining options on campus or around the community?

Unfortunately, we are unable to provide on-campus dining options at this time; however, you may order takeout from restaurants in the Akron area. Your tour guide will be happy to make recommendations.

I am feeling unwell with cold- or flu-like symptoms and/or realized I was exposed to the virus in the past 14 days. Should I visit?

No. We encourage you to take time prior to your visit to consider the state of your health and respond appropriately. We are dedicated to the health of our visitors and staff and ask that you refrain from visiting

if you are exhibiting symptoms or have been exposed to someone who has been ill. You can cancel your visit through your confirmation email. We will work with you to reschedule once you are feeling healthy again.

Can I go on a tour, or visit the Transfer & Adult Enrollment Center, without an appointment?

At this time, we are not accepting walk-in visits. We are happy to work with you to schedule a visit through our website so we can ensure that all accommodations are in place for a safe and enjoyable visit.
