
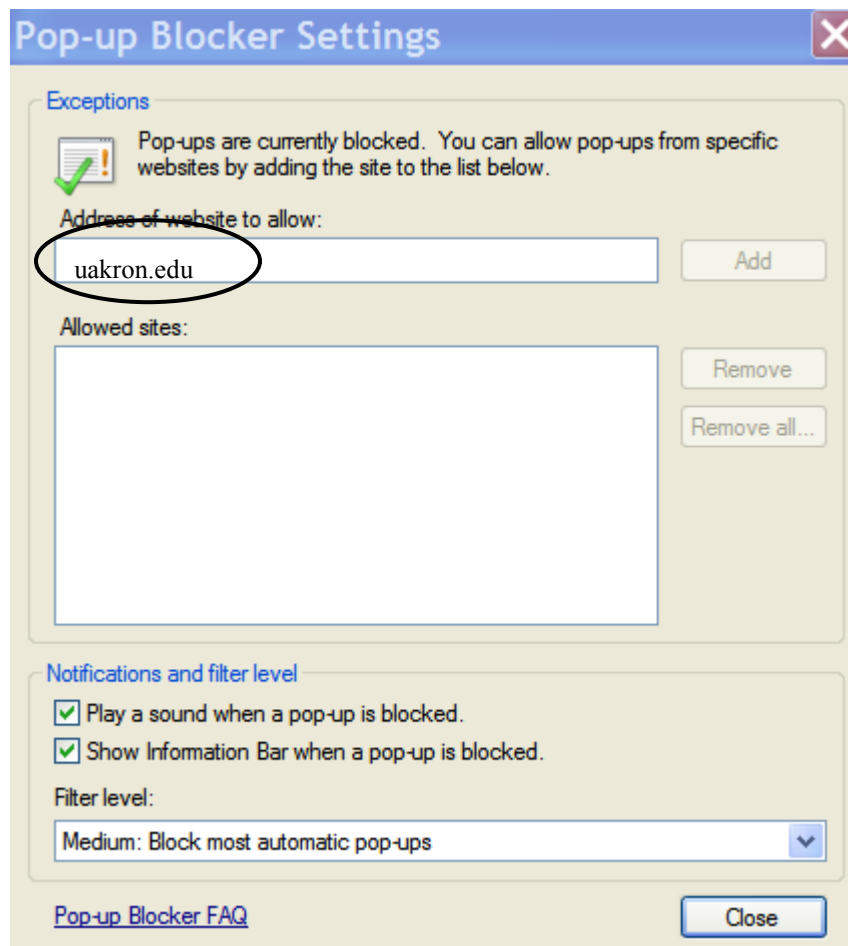


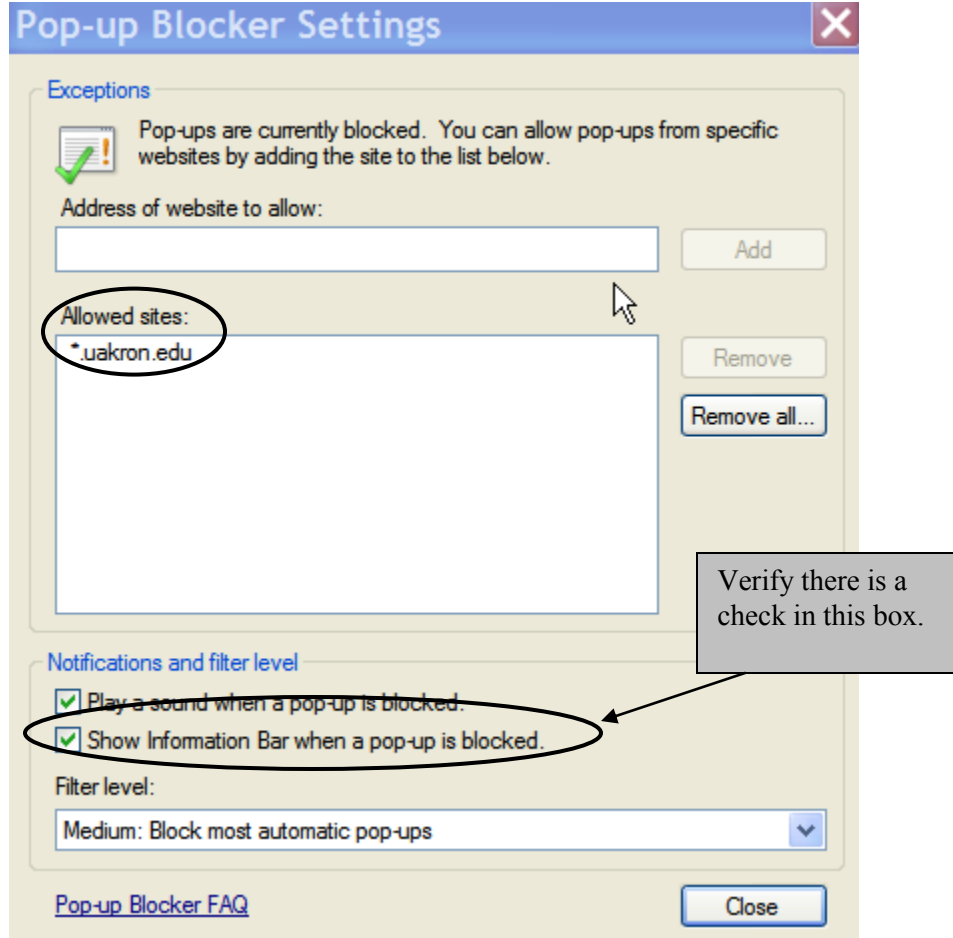
Disable Sites from Pop-Up Blockers in Internet Explorer Version 7

The following instructions are provided to enable pop-ups from The University of Akron web sites.

1. From within Internet Explorer, select the arrow to the right of the  icon and select **Pop-up Blocker – Pop-up Blocker Settings**.
2. Type the following under “Address of Web site to allow:” *uakron.edu*



3. Click the Add button. Under “Allowed sites” you should see ***.uakron.edu**

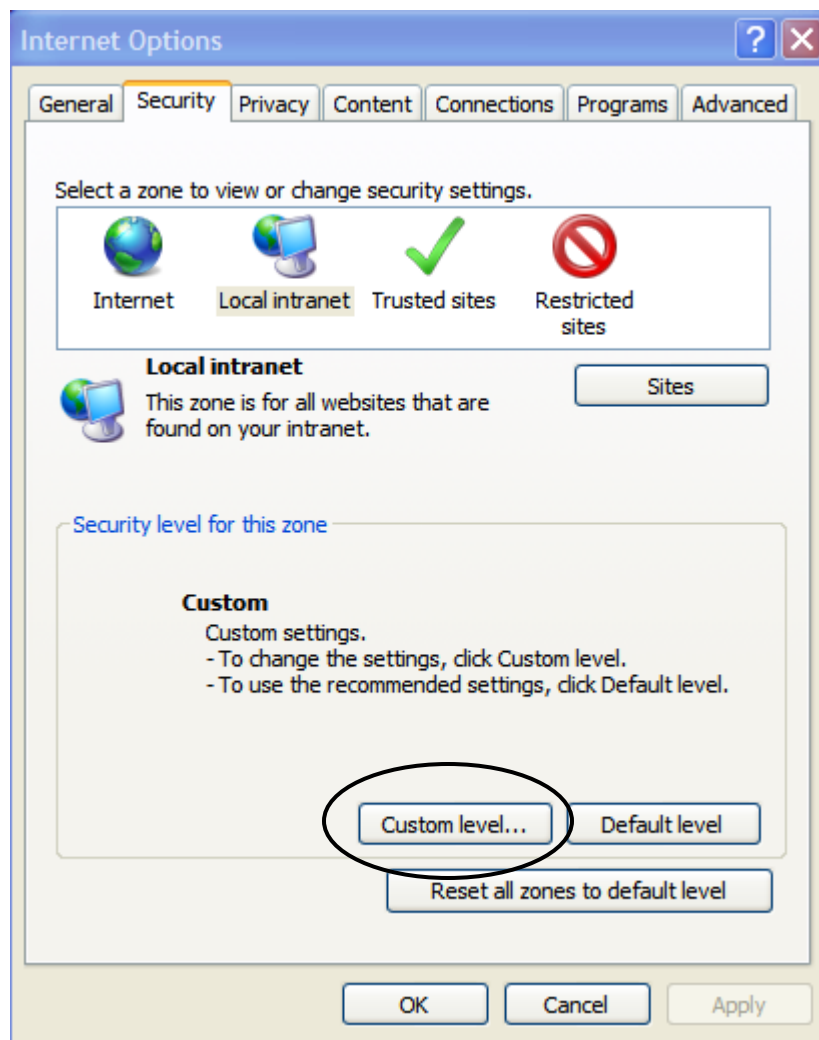


4. Make sure there is a check in the box for “*Show Information Bar when a pop-up is blocked*”.
5. Click the **Close** button.

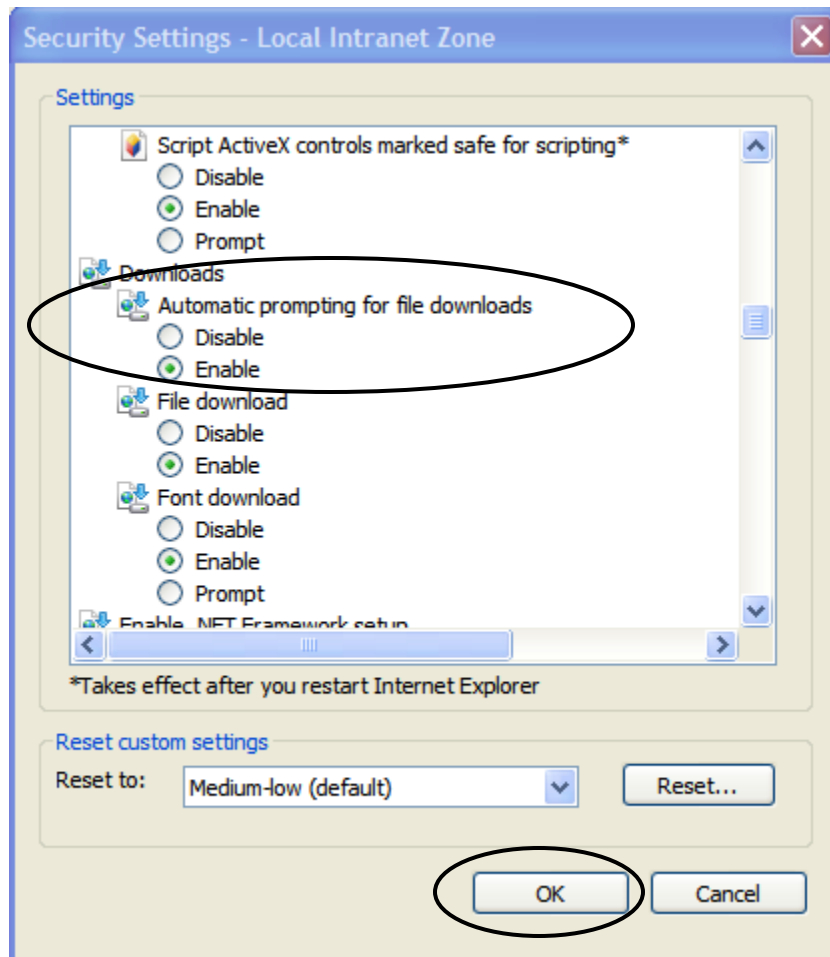
Automatic Prompting for File Downloads

In addition to the pop-up blocker setting, the setting for “automatic prompting for file downloads” should be checked. You should verify that this setting is **enabled**. If this setting is disabled Internet Explorer is unable to prompt you to save or open the file. Therefore, it is a good idea to also check this setting and modify the option, if needed.

1. From within Internet Explorer, select **Tools - Internet Options**.
2. Click the **Security** tab.
3. Click the **Custom Level** button located at the bottom of the screen.



4. Scroll down and locate the heading for “*Automatic prompting for file downloads*”. Make sure the **Enable** radio button is selected. Click the **OK** button.



5. If you made a change to the setting you will be prompted to verify the change – click **Yes**. When you are returned to the Internet Options screen click **OK**.
