HOW TO APPLY

- 1. COMPLETE THE APPLICATION** at uakron.edu/apply.
- 2. SUBMIT TRANSCRIPTS**, including official transcripts from all institutions attended and a final high school transcript or GED score report unless an associates degree has been awarded.

PROVOST SCHOLARSHIP

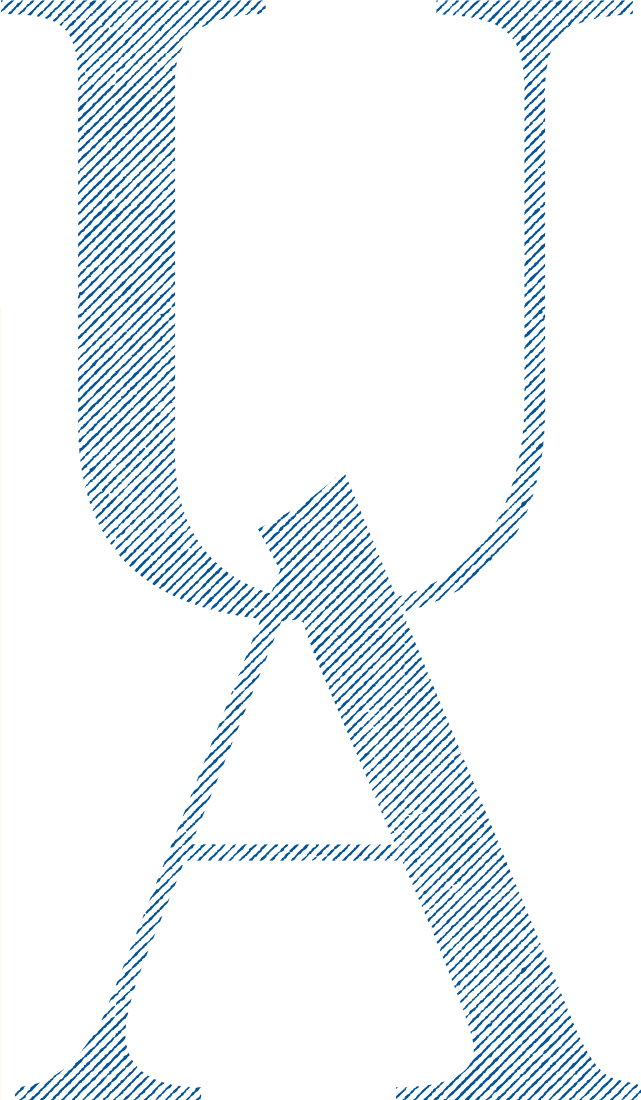
- Students transferring from another regionally accredited college or university in Fall 2022 or later, and have achieved a minimum cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher, will be considered for the **Provost Scholarship**
- Students awarded will receive the scholarship for **six semesters of full-time attendance** or until the completion of a bachelor's degree. Students pursuing an associate degree will also be eligible.

- 93% pass rate on National Council Licensure Examination for Registered Nurses (2019) — above state and national average
- Early Assurance Pathway (EAP) program lets students secure an early seat at Northeast Ohio Medical University (NEOMED) or Lake Erie College of Osteopathic Medicine (LECOM)
- UA students who applied to medical, dental, pharmacy, optometry, veterinary, and physician assistant schools had an acceptance rate above the national average in 2019
